Bustang takes passengers to Monument, Denver, the Union Train Station in Denver, and the Greyhound Bus Station. On Bustang you can also ride to Loveland, Fort Collins, Frisco, Vail, Eagle, and Glenwood Springs.

It began operations on July 13, 2015. The regular cost to Denver is \$12.00.

People who are 65 or older or disabled can get discount tickets of 25% off the regular price. The cost then would be \$9.00

Children 2 through 11 get a 50% discount. That cost would be \$6.00

If you need change such as a \$20.00 bill, it will be given as a slip showing you have a credit of so much money off your next bus ride.

Credit cards are not accepted, but you can purchase tickets with a credit card on the Internet by going to Bustang.Com. Let them know what e-mail you want your tickets delivered.

All Bustangs have reclining seats seating 51 passengers with free Wi-Fi (Internet connection for all passengers). All buses have a bathroom and are wheelchair and bicycle accessible and room for your luggage.

There are 7 round trips daily to Denver daily. 5 trips are early in the morning and 2 others during the day.

On the return trip, 2 buses are during the day to Colorado Springs and 5 in the late afternoon and evening.

There are 5 round trips to Fort Collins and 1 round trip to Glenwood Springs daily.

You may board Bustang at Tejon Park and Ride at I-25, the Downtown Terminal on Kiowa Street, or at Woodman Park and Ride at Corporate Drive. Other stops will be at Monument Park and Ride, which is also called Black Forest, in Denver at Colorado and I-25 for the Light Rail System, and at the Union Station where it will make connections with Amtrak.

If you get off Bustang at the Union Station Gate 3, be sure you to to Gate 3 for your return trip home. Nearly all Light Rails begin at the Union Station and is part of the Denver Bus System.

The Light Rail System (Route A) is now running from the Union Train Station in Denver to DIA every 15 minutes beginning at 3:15am and the last one departing at 12:30am Sunday through Friday. On Saturday the first one leaves at 3:15am and the last one leaves at 1:00 am. The ride is approximately 37 minutes. The cost is \$4.50 for those 65 and older, and you can ride all over Denver for one day without paying any extra. For all others the fee is \$9.00.

The final stop with Bustang is at the Greyhound Bus Depot, also called the Denver Bus Center.

Bustang runs every day of the week between Colorado Springs and Denver, Denver and Fort Collins, and Denver and Glenwood Springs. The Schedules and times are different on weekends.
