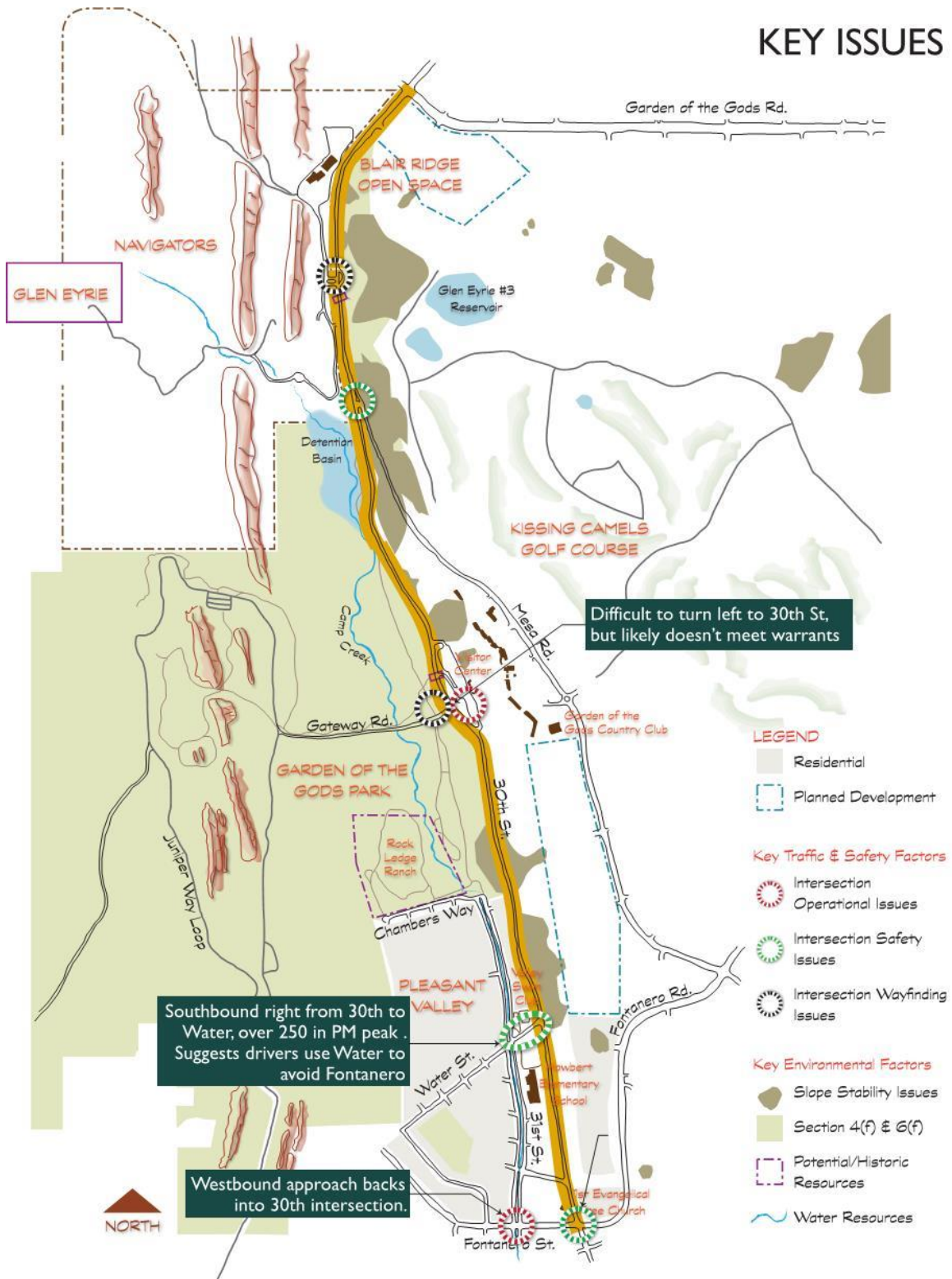

The City of Colorado Springs is developing plans for roadway improvements along 30th Street between Fontanero Street and Mesa Road. This road has been identified as a corridor with needed safety, pavement and drainage improvements that will better facilitate emergency vehicles and provide for an emergency evacuation route.

Design elements include multi-use shoulders, drainage abatement, slope stability and improving intersection geometry to address operational and safety issues. Construction for the first phase project is anticipated to begin spring 2020 and be completed by fall 2021 (Schedule subject to change).
