

PROSPECT LAKE AND MEMORIAL PARK
APRIL 30, 2017

To get to Prospect Lake

From The Downtown Terminal, take Route 1.

After the bus turns on Los Animas Street, there is a bus stop. People going to MMTransit get off there. At the next stop, get off. On your right it is Logan Street. Straight ahead and on your left, the road is Prospect Lake.

If you're coming from the opposite direction by bus, get off just west of Prospect Lake.

As you walk toward the lake, you will notice the Swing High Universally Accessible Playground. You will see more than one type of swing. Check them out. Kids will also enjoy climbing up the tube to slide down the slide, or they may walk up the ramp.

A little north of the playground is The Jaspersen Beach House at 619 Prospect Lake where you may go swimming in the lake. A lifeguard is always on duty during hours of operation.

The swimming hours are 10 am to 5 pm Tuesdays and Thursdays, and Wednesdays 9 am to 3 pm for June, July, and August.

A little past the swimming area, you may go paddle boating or canoeing. It is open from 9 am to 7 pm Tuesdays and Thursdays from May 1 to August 31. Contact Jacob at 719-271-2265.

To return back the way you came by bus, go back to where you got off the bus and walk across the street to catch the Route 1 going in the opposite direction.

Memorial Park

To get to Memorial Park from the downtown terminal, or the Citadel Mall, take Route 7 to Hancock and East Pikes Peak.

To the east of Hancock and just inside the park is The Youth and Adults Sports Office at 1315 East Pikes Peak. Behind it and to the east are basketball courts, volleyball courts, a tennis and handball center, a baseball and football field, and even a place for horseshoes. It is all free. Just bring your own equipment. Their phone number is 719-385-6002.

Perhaps you want to go ice skating. Then get off of Route 7 at East Pikes Peak and Union regardless of what direction you are coming from on Route 7.

The address is 1705 East Pikes Peak. To get there after getting off the bus, walk south and west inside the park. There are many activities at The Sertich Ice Center. See what one is best for you by calling 719-385-5983.

Be sure to check out the Y indoor swimming at 280 S. Union. Whether you are coming from the downtown terminal or The Citadel Mall on Route 7, get off at Union and Parkside. You will notice a

large white tent. Walk south of it and then go west on the grass to the building, or you may want to walk up to the road where automobiles enter.

Hours of operation are

Monday through Friday	7:30 am to 8:30 pm
Saturdays	9:00 am to 6:00 pm
Sundays	8:00 am to 5:00 pm.

There are also swimming activities. Call 719-385-5984.
