**RE: Certificate of Designation – Stericycle, Inc.
4120 Mark Dabling Boulevard**

In accordance with the Colorado Department of Health and Environment's "Solid Waste Disposal Sites and Facilities Act" (part 1 of article 20 of title 30, Colorado Revised Statutes, and published in the Code of Colorado Regulations at 6 CCR 1007.2, and any subsequent amendments thereto, City Ord. 94-21; Ord. 01-42) the below described application for a Certificate of Designation is being referred to the City Planning Commission for consideration on December 15, 2016 at 4120 Mark Dabling Boulevard.

Stericycle, Inc., on behalf of Thunderbolt Management Group, Inc., is requesting approval of a Certificate of Designation to operate a medical waste transfer facility. The subject site, 4120 Mark Dabling Boulevard, consists of 4.08 acres and is zoned M-1/SS (Light Industrial with a Streamside Overlay). The site will consolidate and temporarily store medical waste from certified medical facilities. The site will not treat or dispose said waste on site but will function for the purposes of consolidation and transfer to an existing designated disposal location.
