- All park property is designated non-smoking (to include electronic devices, marijuana, tobacco) as defined by City Ordinance #17-7 (6.6.201, 6.6.202, 6.6.203)
- All alcoholic beverages are prohibited in city parks.
- Ordinance No. 21-9-410.
- Groups of 15 or more need to complete a reservation agreement for weekday use.
- The site will close lightening, temperature of 65 degrees or below and for inclement weather.

- Parking is limited.
