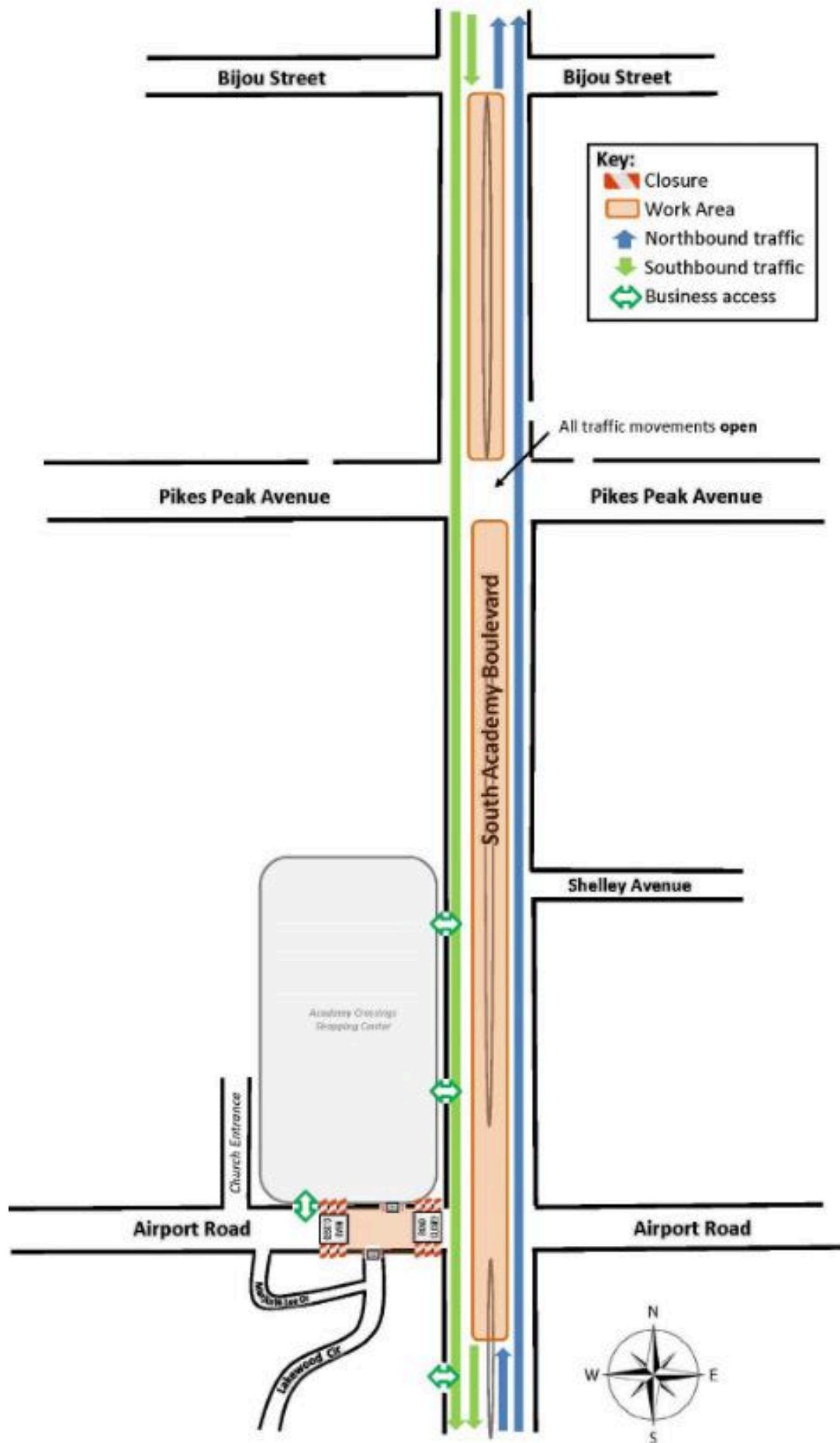
CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

(All schedules are weather and resource dependent)

There will be no impacts, except for the ongoing full closure of Airport Road, over the holiday weekend beginning the afternoon of July 3 through the morning of July 8.

Traffic Impacts on South Academy Boulevard between Bijou Street and Airport Road

South Academy Boulevard between Bijou Street and Airport Road reopened. The night of Tuesday, July 2 crews will move travel lanes on South Academy Boulevard to the outside of the roadway between Bijou Street and Airport Road to build the new medians and pave the inside lanes with new asphalt. When adjusting travel lanes northbound South Academy Boulevard will reopen to two lanes of traffic, southbound traffic will remain as a single lane. All traffic movements will remain open at Bijou Street and Pikes Peak Avenue. See map below.



Airport Road remains closed west of South Academy Boulevard. All business entrances remain open and accessible throughout this work. Expect delays and use alternative routes. [CLICK HERE](#) to view closure/detour map.

Jet Wing Drive remains closed south of Hancock Expressway

Jet Wing Drive remains fully closed at South Academy Boulevard to support the underground work on the east side of the roadway. Traffic will detour north to Hancock Expressway to access South Academy Boulevard. Crews will reopen Jet Wing Drive once underground work progresses north.

Stay Informed

The South Academy Boulevard Improvements Project addresses aging pavement, curb and gutter, and improves drainage along the project corridor. To provide for better multi-modal and pedestrian access, a new multi-use path is being constructed on one side of Academy Boulevard. Due to existing drainage issues and occasional occurrences of standing water in the roadway, significant drainage improvements are being made.

This is a voter-approved, Pikes Peak Rural Transportation Authority (PPRTA) A-listed project. Estimated cost to address aging pavement, curb and gutter, and improve drainage along the project corridor: \$62 million.
